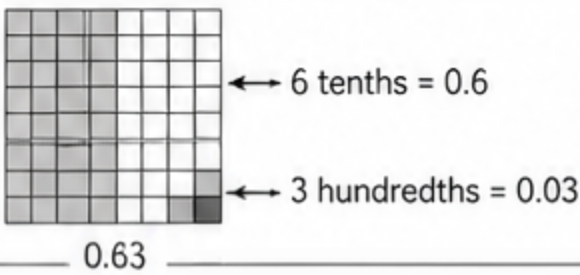

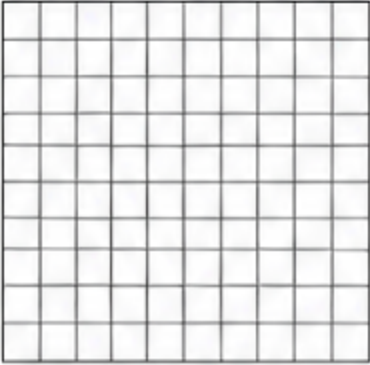
Decimal Place Value Grid

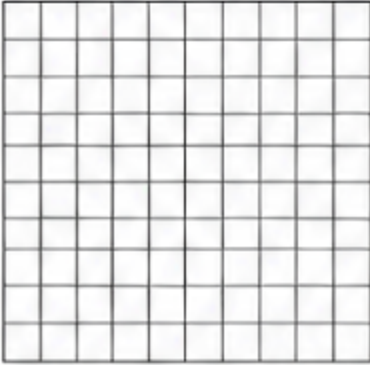
